RECREATION

The active program consists of ice-breakers, initiative, innovative and trust games and energisers.

An alternative to skill development whereby children develop problem-solving, communication, team-work and co-operative skills. Challenges vary depending on age group.

Combine craft and other OSHC activities with outdoor activity.

Common themes include Easter, Halloween, Christmas, Kids Olympics, Wild West, and Hollywood.

COMBO GAMES

Great for older children who are tired of the traditional sports. GSG strategically modifies the rules of more than one sport to ensure high participation for all children & games are age appropriate.

GAME SENSE

Where the game is the focus of the activity rather than the technique. Game Sense encourages children to develop tactics & strategies. Players are responsible for the game and its outcomes.

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MORE GAMES

LITTLE EQUIPMENT GAMES

Fast moving activities that promote age appropriate challenges & high participation. As the name suggests, they require little equipment & organisation. Children never tire of these games. - they play them over & over again.

EASY TO REMEMBER GAMES

Active, exciting age appropriate challenges that promote high participation. As the name suggests, they comprise of simple rules with easy modifications.

SIMPLE BALL GAMES

Keep it Simple. Ball games with few rules and plenty of action. Participation for all children. Learn to Play...Just for Fun. Easy to repeat and requires little equipment.

INDOOR GAMES

Ideal for centres with limited space and great for wet weather days. Require minimal organisation and little equipment.

BLINDFOLD GAMES

Games that promote communication, co-operative, trust, balance and navigational skills. An enjoyable challenge for the older children.

CIRCUITS

A sequence of activities, whereby children participate in self-directed challenges. Circuits can be based on theme or be recreation or sport specific. Suitable for all ages.

AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Don't forget that GSG also visits After School Care centres on a weekly or fortnightly basis to provide skill development in a variety of sports and games or the development.

All programs are conducted by Physical Education Teachers, student teachers and sport coaches.
